Please contact the Conference Secretariat at BICET2021secretariat@utb.edu.bn should there be any problem with submission. All papers will go through peer review and the authors whose papers are accepted for presentation will receive an invitation letter from the Conference Secretariat. At least one of the authors of accepted paper must register and present the paper during the conference. All peer-reviewed papers shall be included in the AIP Conference Proceedings which is indexed by Scopus (Elsevier), Conference Proceedings Citation Index (Web of Science) and Inspec.



A special invitation goes out to authors from the industry to submit a 1-page extended abstract to be considered for oral presentation only. However, if full paper is submitted and accepted, it will be included in the AIP Conference Proceedings.
