



RECIPROCAL SCHEME (RBS)

Members can borrow books from 12 participating academic libraries such as; Universiti Brunei Darussalam, Universiti Islam Sultan Sharif Ali, Politeknik Brunei, Kolej Universiti Perguruan Ugama Seri Begawan, and many more. You can visit our library website under Services > Reciprocal Borrowing Scheme for the details.



STUDY CARRELS

You can find study carrels on every level and almost every corner of our library. Feel free to use any one of it.



OPAC WORKSTATION

An OPAC workstation is provided at every level. This is used to search for resources from the library collection.



24/7 STUDY AREA

A place where you can study for 24 hours and 7 days without worries. We provide this room specifically for those who need a place to study after our closing hours.



LOCKER

Library users can make use of the lockers provided outside the library to safe keep your belongings. This service can be requested from the Main Counter using your UTB ID Card. Remember to renew your key locker every two (2) hours at the Main Counter.



FAWAZ TRAINING ROOM

Fawaz Training Room consists of a projector, television, and whiteboard that are ready to be used for any training session, presentation, or mini-conferences. This room can accommodate up to 30 people and you need to book in advance from the Main Counter before using it.



MINI LIBRARY CUBE

Interesting and useful items such as notebooks, pencil cases, bags, stationeries, and many more can be purchased here. Payment can be done at the Main Counter.



SYNDICATE ROOM

Total of 7 syndicate rooms ready to be used by UTB Library members. Syndicate Room 1 to Syndicate Room 6 can accommodate at least 6 people, while Syndicate Room 7 can put up to 12 people. Most people use these syndicate rooms for group discussions and meetings.



LIBRARY PRINT SHOP (LPS)

We provide services from printing, photocopy, and binding along with giving the front-and-back cover. Take note that we only accept material to be printed via email (PDF format). Our LPS email is libraryprintshop@utb.edu.bn, visit our LPS counter for further information.



PRESENTATION CORNER

A projector and a few chairs are ready to be used anytime. Students or staff are most welcome here.

Different concepts and themes can be seen every year.




KID'S BOOK CAVE




4 MAR - Soft opening of Baker & Books at UTB Library Café area.


