LIBRARY DICTIONARY

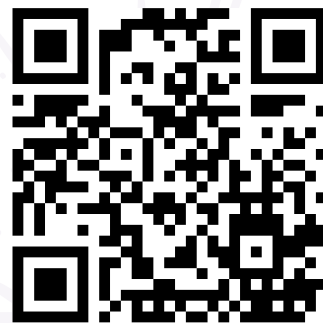
e-Book - A digital version of a book that can be viewed on, and sometimes downloaded to, a computer or other electronic device.

Library Database - An online searchable collection or electronic collection of published works subscribed by a library that is usually related to the academic programs offered at the university. Most databases can be searched by fields like title, sub title and author of article and publication, and also by date of publication. Examples of library database are ScienceDirect, Scopus, Perlego, JSTOR, Nexis Uni, ProQuest One Business, Google Scholar, EBSCOhost, etc.
