A new staff, Norbaizurah binti Mohamad joined UTB library as Pekerja Tingkat II Bergaji Hari in May 2021.




General/lending collections can be found in both Level 2 and Level 3. Look for a book marked in yellow coloured spine label.


# **Islamic Collection**




# **FOREIGN MISSION COLLECTION**



**Secondary sources** - Materials such as books and journal articles that analysed primary sources. It usually provides evaluation or interpretation of data or evidence found in original research or documents.
